


## **Covenant privileges and Covenant obligations**

*For us, the fact that covenant privileges require covenant obligations is fulfilled corporately every time we come to the Lord's Table as his redeemed people, to eat the bread and drink the wine, in remembrance that every good we have is entirely the gift of his grace. ### Study 8: Restored!
